

Variety Show Job Descriptions

Here are the Sixth Grade Crew Jobs for the 2019 Variety Show. It includes a description of the job, approximate number of people needed for each job, and approximate time it will take to successfully perform the job. These numbers are subject to change depending on the changing needs of the show.

Please check your schedule and your family's schedule before choosing a job to ensure you are able to meet the time commitment. Permission slips are needed for all jobs. They are located on the Stenwood Elementary School website.

Master of Ceremonies (MC) - 3-5 slots

If you are comfortable speaking in front of a crowd, this job is for you! The MC introduces the acts in the show. You will be responsible for writing the material you perform, so we are looking for someone that is creative, too. You have to audition to get this part, and we will be looking for your creativity and at home preparedness. Tryouts date will be sent to kids that sign up for MC. **Time commitment** - Rehearsal #1, Rehearsal #2, Technical Rehearsal and Variety Show (see dates below). There will also be extra training for this job during lunch time or recess.

Stage Manager - 1 Lead and 1 Assistant

The Stage Manager makes sure that get on and off stage in a timely fashion. You need to feel comfortable directing your peers and thinking quickly on your feet. If you like a challenge and responsibility, this is for you!

Time commitment - Audition, Rehearsal #1, Rehearsal #2, Technical Rehearsal and Variety Show (see dates below). There will also be extra training for this job during lunch time or recess.

Performance Assistant (PA) - 6 slots

PAs work with the performers. You lead them from the waiting area to the backstage area, and you stay with them until after they are finished performing. You keep the performers company, ease their nerves, keep them quiet and get them where they need to be.

Time commitment - Rehearsal #1, Rehearsal #2 and Variety Show (see dates below). There may be extra training for this job during lunch time or recess.

Stage Hands - 6 slots

You help behind the scenes with the props. Whether it's a piano, a chair, or a music stand you are on hand to move props on and off stage, quickly.

Time commitment - Rehearsal #1, Rehearsal #2, Technical Rehearsal and Variety Show (see dates below). There will also be extra training for this job during lunch time or recess.

Music Production - 2 slots

Are you good with music on an iPad? Are you good under pressure? Then this job is for you. You help with playing the music during audition, rehearsals and the show.

Time commitment - Variety Show Auditions, Rehearsal #1, Rehearsal #2, Technical Rehearsal and Variety Show (see dates below). There will also be extra training for this job during lunch time or recess.

Art Crew - 12 slots

You will make posters for the show. Materials will be sent home so you can do this job on your own or with some friends.

Time Commitment - Certain designated during or after school meetings.

Advertising Specialist - 2 slots

You will help hang posters and hand out brochures on the day of the show.

Time Commitment - Variety Show and possible during and after school meetings.

Ushers - 2 slots

You help with ushering parents to their seats, guiding them to fill in all the seats and helping to ensure that people do not enter or exit while an act is in progress.

Time Commitment - Variety Show and possible during or after school meetings.
